Dear Sir,

As a citizen, I am writing this letter to state my position on the following issues. Since the Vishva Hindu Parishad is an important participant in several of these issues, a copy of this letter is being sent to that organization.

1. On the subject of the temple at Ramjanmabhoomi (and all the other “disputed sites” referred to by the VHP):

I DO NOT want a temple at the exact site of the mosque or anywhere near it. I expect parliament to enact suitable legislation clearly forbids such acts of converting mosques to temples.

2. On the position of the VHP that “religious sentiments of people supercedes the rule of the law”:

Our nation is governed by the rule of the law. Any “sentiment” of the people that is in violation of the law of the land is not justified. If such sentiments are really those of the majority, that would be reflected by suitable legislation in parliament. Such is the system of our government.

3. On the Assertion by the VHP that it represents all Hindus:

I am a Hindu. The VHP DOES NOT represent me or speak for me in ANY WAY. I am NOT and have no intention of BEING a member of the VHP.
